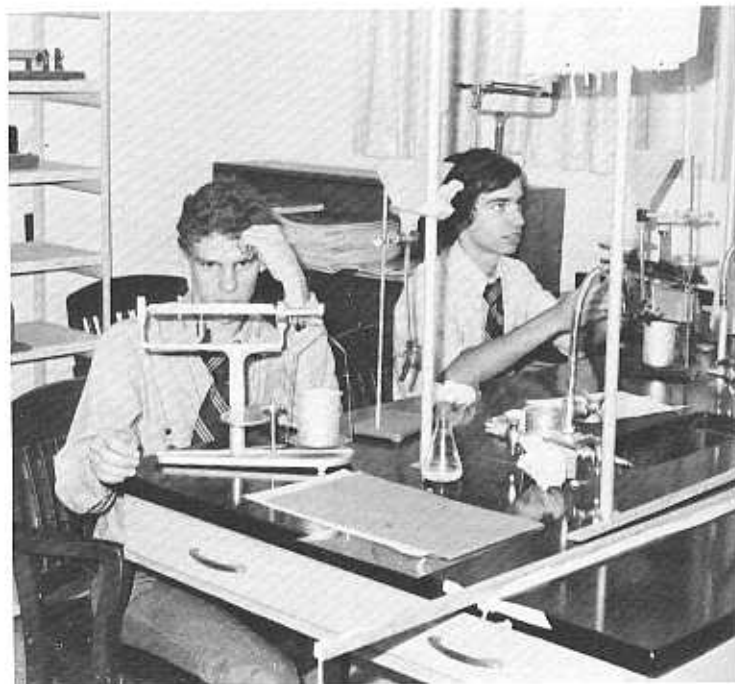


We have fun;
