

Course: Speech

The Camp Donoho Speech course is designed to build strong communication and interpersonal skills while promoting self-confidence. Students will learn to become organized and gain experience in writing and persuasive speaking. As the students learn about the process of writing a speech they will be presenting speeches individually and with others by working with partners and in groups. The students will present several different speeches each week as they learn about the various styles of public speaking. Students will be responsible for writing their speeches and completing online assignments on the days that they are not in class at school. Each student will be required to have access to the course via laptop and Google Classroom, an active email address, loose leaf paper, index cards, and a few visual aids that they will bring from home as the course progresses. Students will review some of the greatest speeches of all time and learn to evaluate and critique these performances as well as provide feedback and constructive criticism for their peers. The Final will be given at a lunch at the Classic on Noble with the entire class and parents or special invited guests. (the price of the lunch is not included) Both the physical and technical aspects of verbal communication will be evaluated during the presentation of each speech. Each speech will be graded on the following: organization; use of visual aids; written assignments such as outlines, rough drafts, and index cards; the planning and rehearsal process as well as the delivery of each speech. By the end of the course, students will have experimented with many different styles of public speaking and will be more effective communicators.
