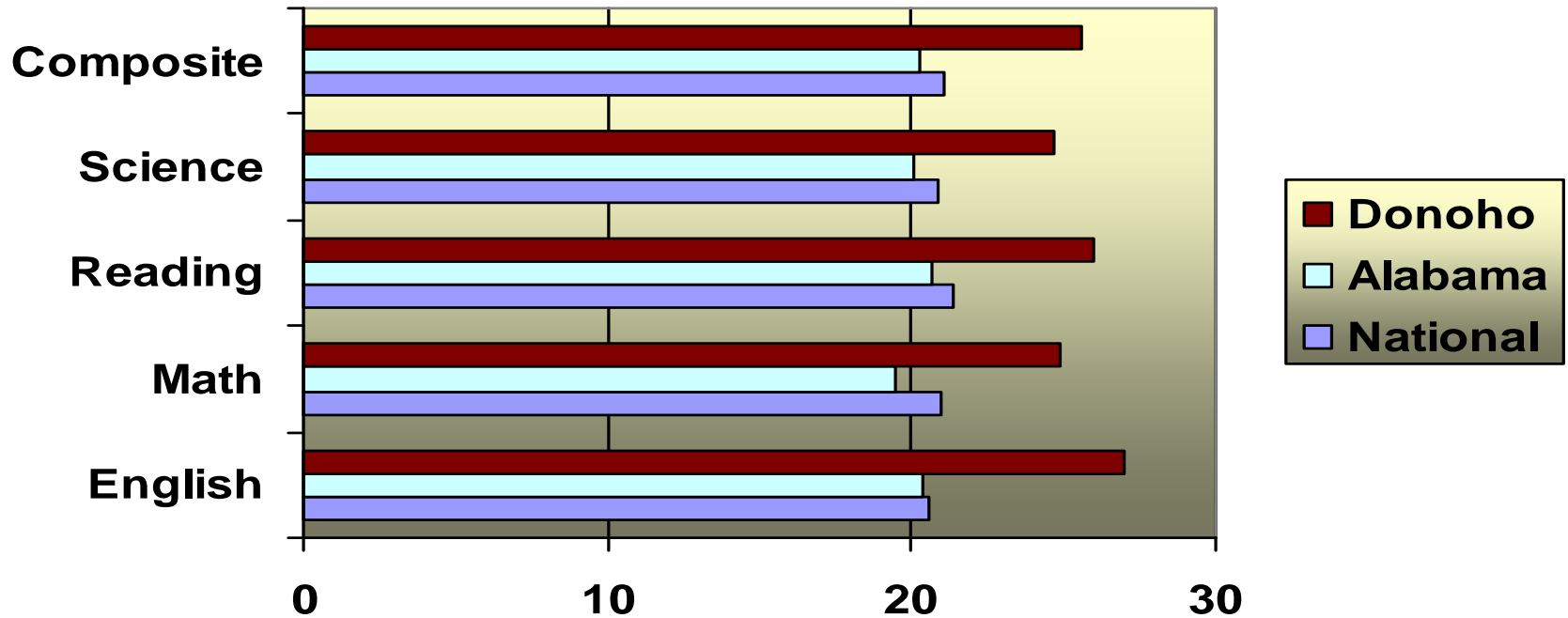

Grade equivalent scores are considered by many the best way to monitor progress over the years. Tracking by class instead of grade level reveals that each group has made steady advances over the course of the past three years.

Grade equivalent scores are normed according to the year (kindergarten is zero, first grade is one, etc.) and month (August is zero, September is one, etc.) so that 0.6 equates to the sixth month of kindergarten. Since we tested in February, grade equivalent norms are 0.6-8.6.

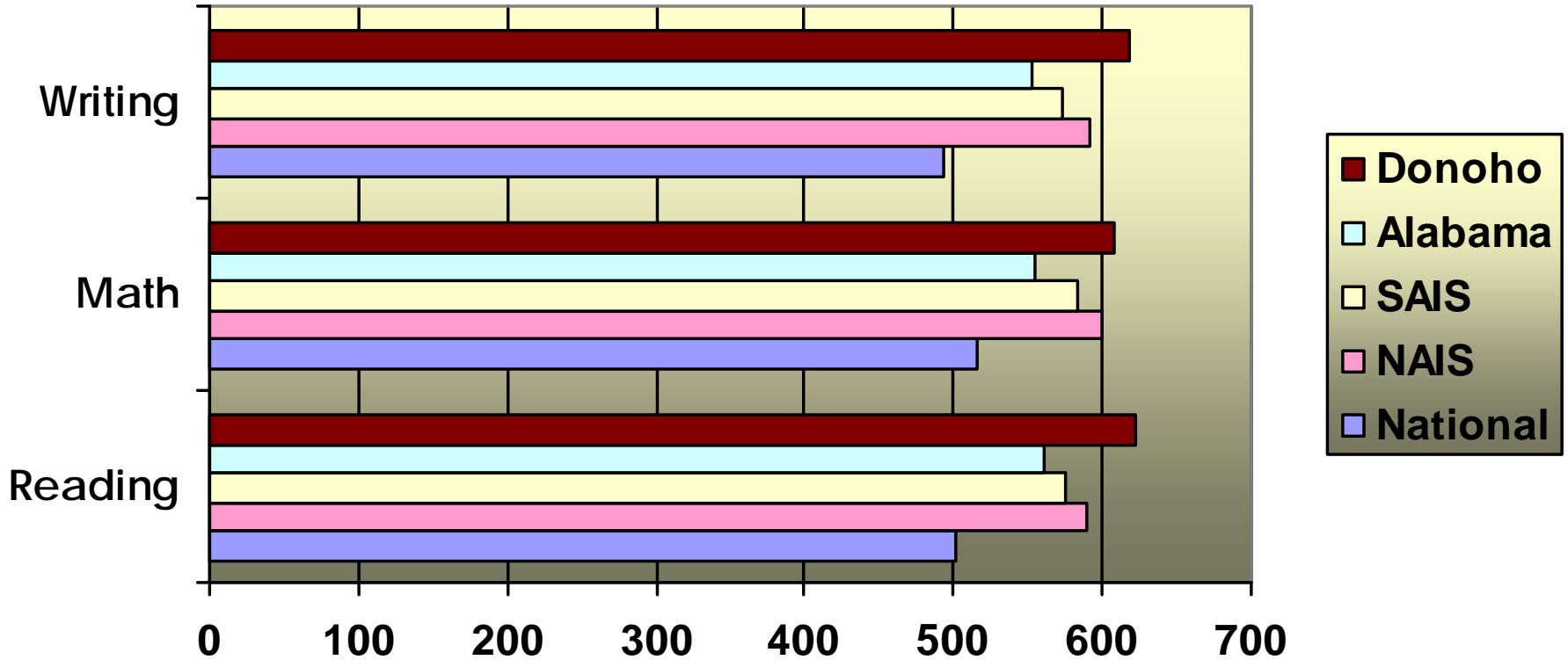
