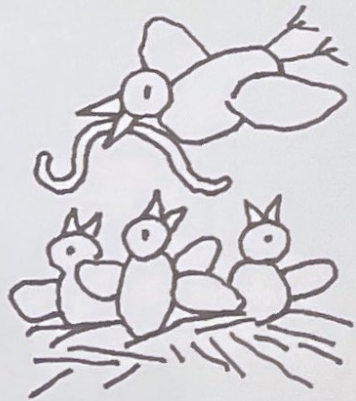

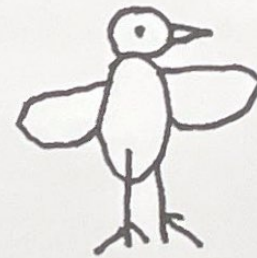
Our teachers offer active instruction and special attention to individual growth.

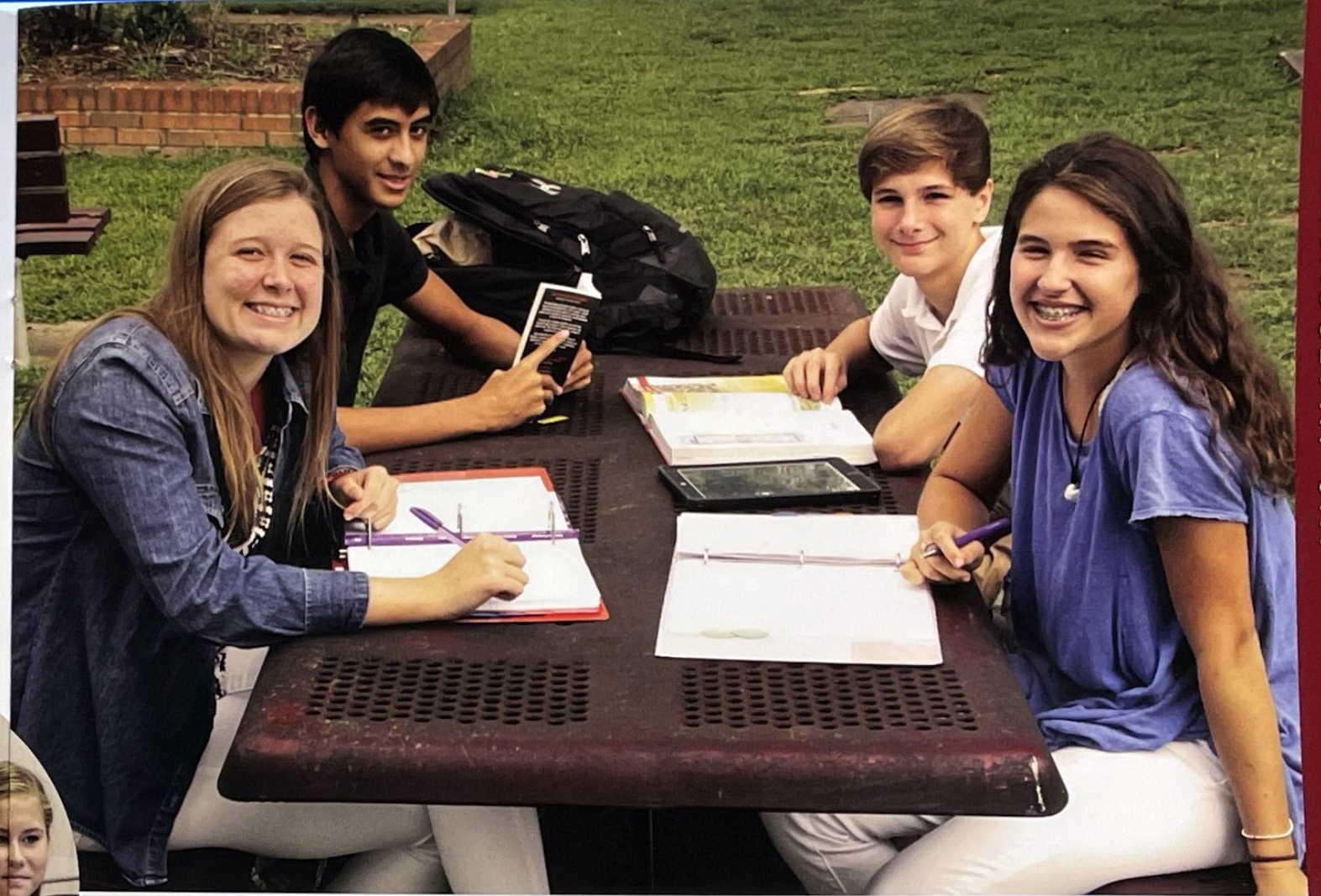

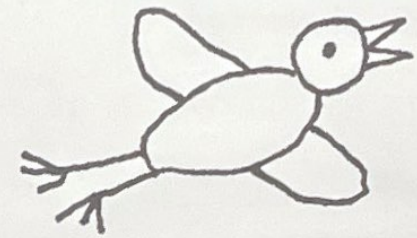
Middle School students utilize daily study halls to aid in the transition to high school.

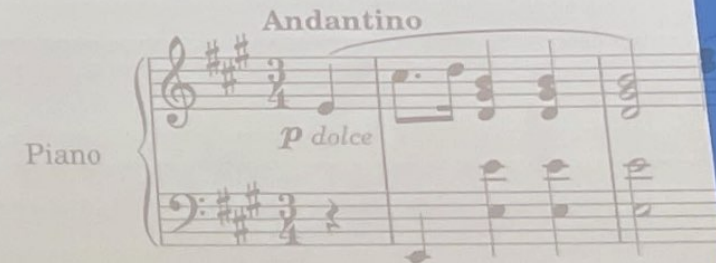

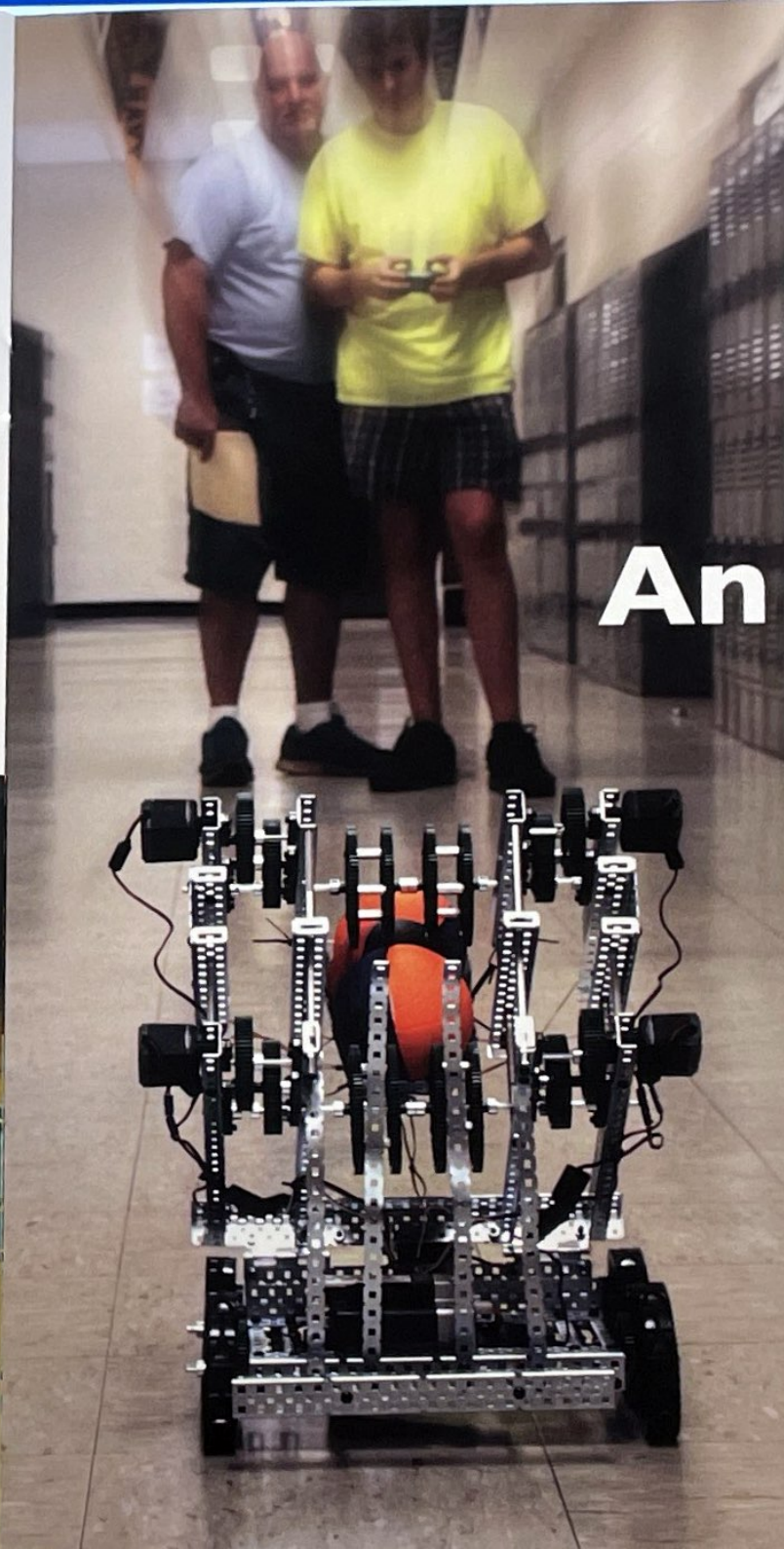
